

I have written a message in a secret code below. If

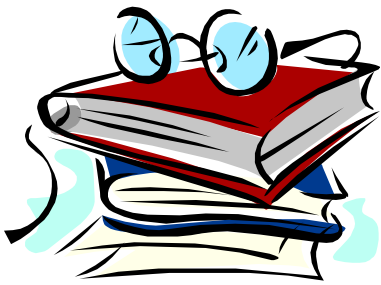
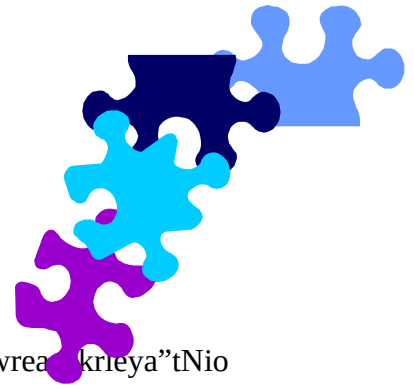
